

Fit4schools Report 3

I am pleased to report to you following the completion of Assessment 3 which has been conducted at Thurnby Lodge Primary School. Enclosed is data outlining the Overall School Improvement along with comparisons between each class.

- Overall School Improvement of 21.53%
- Girls made an overall improvement of 14.61 %
- Girls in KS1 made an overall improvement of 16.89%
- Girls in KS2 made an overall improvement of 14.05%
- Boys made an overall improvement of 27.02%
- Boys in KS1 made an overall improvement of 2.83%
- Boys in KS2 made an overall improvement of 33.36%
- Pupil Premium children made an overall improvement of 25.35%
- SEN children made an overall improvement of 16.30%
- EAL girls overall score increased by 4.58%
- EAL boys overall score increased by 30.78%

Based on this evidence, it is pleasing to see that every class has made an overall improvement on their score. Although Year 2's percentage improvement did not increase, this was because two less children participated in the assessment. The average class score increased as you can see in the table.

It is recommended that class teachers view the results of both their 'Overall Class Improvement Report' and 'Overall Student Improvement Report' to identify any activities where children or the class are not making progress. These activities should now be incorporated into PE sessions by class teachers to enable improvements to be made before the next assessment.

Attached with this report is a list of the highest scorers and most improved to be displayed on your PE board, shared with children and mentioned in assembly and on your newsletter! The pdf certificate template attached previously should be used to print and write children's names (let me know if you need me to send this again)
